Statement of Event:

On December 14, 2006, permit number 58153 was issued by the State of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality to Jordan Development Company, LLC to drill and operate the natural gas well, AG-A-Ming 4-12 HD and HD1 in the Antrim Formation (API numbers 21-009-58153-00-00 and 21-009-58153-01-00). The permit is in the attached file, LINGO_42931_WellPermits.pdf

Anticipated Impacts:

The conditions of the Go/No-Go Decision Point were met when Permit 58153 was issued before December 31, 2006. The project is ready to proceed on to the remaining Tasks outlined in the Statement of Project Objectives. Jordan Development anticipates spudding the LINGO well in late January and we can expect their invoices and cost-share to be submitted shortly thereafter.

Action Recommended:

Michigan Tech is requesting authorization from the DOE Project Officer and DOE Contract Officer to continue the project beyond Phase 1, Task 2, which allows MTU to draw funds from the original DOE budget of \$499,672 and confirms the project end date of 9/30/08.
